Here's a step-by-step description of how easy it is to install your Liberty Collection outdoor kitchen for tonight's barbecue.



1

Begin by attaching the side panels and top riser to the outdoor refrigerator and removing the plastic skin that protects the finish. This is designed to prepare the unit to attach to the rest of the Liberty Collection and solid surface tops.



2

Link the carts and bend units before placing the cooking and grill heads on them. This provides a sturdy base for the grill, burners and sink units. The carts are easily linked with a bolt, washer and nut located on the front and back.



3

Please note that the Liberty head units are shipped prepared for installation in fixed islands. For a multiple-unit cart configuration, remove the angle brackets that are in place and replace them with the cart mounted brackets.



Bend units enable your outdoor kitchen to easily fit into its surroundings.



4

Take all removable components out of grill and cooking heads for easier lifting. Place heads on top of the previously connected carts so that the rear tabs slide easily into place and guide the head through to the front.



Enlist the help of at least one person when lifting the grill heads.



5

Make sure the leading ledge sits flush on top of the cart. Then secure the head of the cart with provided screws, starting with the rear and finishing with the front.



6

Replace burners, drip pan, and other pieces on grill and cooking heads. Hook up propane tank to all grill and side burner units (see Liberty Use & Care manual for detailed instructions).



7

Attach brackets and support frame for back corner unit. This will provide additional counter space for easier food preparation and more room for your guests to join in and experience the grilling fun.



Add even more counter space with optional side shelves, available on all units.



8

Place solid surface tops on to side, bend units and back corner brackets. The pieces rest securely in the brackets. Deep storage in the bend units is accessed through door on the back side.



New refrigeration units can be fitted with solid surface tops, which expand prep space.



9

Fill each radiant with 18 ceramic rods and secure the radiant end cap. This ceramic heating technology ensures even heat. Place in grill unit and cover with grates. With all the elements in place, you're now ready to experience the ultimate in outdoor entertaining and cooking performance with DCS by Fisher & Paykel's Liberty Collection.
